WHY DO HEAVILY BET FAVORITES LOSE?



Good question **Trackpro!** Favorites lose somewhere between sixty to seventy percent of all races run at every track in the country. Not everyday of course, but over time for sure. So, racing fans should keep in mind that every time they empty their wallets on horses that leave the gate as the heavily bet post time favorite, they are most likely going to lose every penny of their hard earned money! Now think about that for a moment. By betting the horse that the general public thinks has the best chance to win, and that includes the wisdom gleaned from thousands of racing fans scouring the racing headlines, studying the past performances, betting top jockeys and trainers, tracking tote board odds, and using so called “consensus” selections from professionals, they are still going to lose most of the time. So does betting the post time favorite to win make any financial sense

at all? The answer is probably sometimes, but only under certain circumstances for sure. And one of those circumstances for **Trackpro** personally, is that at an absolute minimum, the favorite must be at least **9/5** odds or higher on the tote board.

TEN POSSIBLE REASONS WHY POST TIME FAVORITES LOSE

1	The horse may have won previous races against weak competition, or under ideal conditions that will not repeat.
2	A wet or muddy track, or a surface the horse has not previously raced on.
3	The favorite is coming off a long layoff, and may not be in top form.
4	The favorite is showing inconsistent workouts, or has never had a workout over the track.
5	The favorite is trying a new distance for the first time, or has failed to win at the distance in previous races.
6	The favorite is moving up in class.
7	The favorite is making its first career start.
8	The favorite is going off form, or may have expended too much energy in its last race.
9	The favorite stumbled, or did not break well from the gate.
10	The favorite experienced traffic problems during the race, or took a bad turn, or was forced to run wide.

So here is my point: Knowing that favorites are more likely to lose than win by a wide margin, does it make financial sense to wager to win on such horses? With a few exceptions, the answer for the most part is NO! Racing fans that hope to profit at the race track betting to win, should steer far clear of the post time favorite, and especially so if the odds are below even money. The betting public has a strong tendency to bet horses way below their actual chance of winning, and that is a major problem for racing fans hoping to walk out of the track, or their simulcast center with a profit in their pockets. And then of course the track takeout also needs to be considered. Favorites will finish first or second in about sixty percent of the races run, or thereabouts, so sometimes it may make sense to use them when combined with overlays in an Exacta, or maybe even

the Daily Double. Listed below are four horrendous examples of losing favorites from the racing at Mahoning Valley this past Wednesday:

FAVORITES – RISK VERSUS REWARD

Another key point **Trackpro** wants to make in this newsletter is that racing fans should not count on any horse to win, just because the betting public has pounded the odds down to pennies on the dollar! **Trackpro** listed ten reasons why a favorite could lose in the table above, and there are obviously many more



reasons which I have not listed. What about the possibility of a jockey falling off the horse, or the stewards disqualifying a horse for interference, or for some other infraction. But the betting public does not seem to care one bit about risk versus reward do they? No, they do not. The betting public tends to think like a “herd” sort of speak, putting their hard earned

money on the favorite to win regardless of the odds, probably thinking to themselves that “somebody must know something”, or saying to themselves “Not everybody can be wrong”. Well, if those two statements were true, why did the four heavily bet horses shown above lose at Mahoning Valley? And yesterday at Aqueduct, the post time favorite lost in *seven* of the *eight* races run! Now there are days when the favorite will win the majority of races too, but that does not negate the horse racing risk versus reward equation one bit. The fact remains that horse racing is competitive and risky, and there is no such thing as a “lock” no matter how much money the betting public wagers on a horse.

The **TRACKPRO 9/5 WAGERING RULE** is based on the premise that horses bet below **9/5** odds on the tote board as shown below in the table, are probably bet well below their actual chances of winning the race. In other words, these horses are heavily bet underlays for the most part, and should be avoided in my opinion. For racing fans that insist on betting horses below **9/5** odds, here is a table of the expected payoffs if the horse wins:

AQUEDUCT – 02/19/2026 – R8 – 50 CENT LISTED PICK 5 PAYS A WALLET-BUSTING - \$9,182.62!

The powerful **Trackpro Value Rating (TPV)** algorithm listed the **50 cent** late PICK 5 (1 x 2 x 3 x 4 x 3) at Aqueduct yesterday that paid a whopping **\$9,182.62** for subscribers! And the **50 cent** PICK 4 (2 x 3 x 4 x 3) paid an incredible **\$2,325.12!** These two fantastic horizontal payoffs were almost listed in the top three

selections, except for the winner in R7 which was listed fourth in the handicapped report. And what **Trackpro** found particularly interesting in the sequence is that the relatively new **POWER RATING (PR)** algorithm listed the late \$2.00 Daily Double in R8 COLD which paid a hefty **\$181.62!**

The winner in the first leg of the listed PICK 5 was the #8 LUCKY DUDE (\$6.24). This seven year old gelding sired by LOOKIN AT LUCKY was marked with a total of five powerful **Trackpro Handicapping Tools!** And not only that, the **TPV** rating at **2.68** towered over the second selection by a full **sixty-seven** points! There is no point in spending too much time writing about this winner because the past performances clearly show there was plenty to like from a handicapping perspective. The Brisnet Prime Power also ranked this gelding right on top. This gelding was showing three wins at the seven furlong distance, and was coming off back to back wins with an improving speed rating! And not only that, the race two back was a “big win” demonstrating this gelding was full of run, and clearly in sharp form. The Brisnet speed rating in the report at **93** was the highest from the listed selections, and the last workout was highly ranked also.

The **TPV** algorithm did an excellent job of handicapping R5 at Aqueduct yesterday listing the winner #10 CALLING AN AUDIBLE (**\$21.44**) second in the report for **Trackpro** subscribers. This five year old mare sired by AUDIBLE was showing the highest listed **POWER RATING (PR)** in the report, and won by a nose at **9-1** odds to absolutely explode the three consecutive declining speed ratings (**74-66-54**), and the two consecutive out of the money finishes. But the **TPV** algorithm is very powerful and sophisticated, and thought this mare had a very good chance to upset the field, and it was “spot on”. Let's be honest, the entire ten horse field was very weak to begin with, and in poor form for the most part. But the race favorite #6 SPIRIT OF ESTHER did figure to win the most based on the **Trackpro** figures in the report. The **TPV** handicapped the \$2.00

Exacta that paid a rock solid **\$101.52** in the top two selections, and the listed **50 cent Triple** paid **\$67.90** which was listed in the top three selections.
