Good morning Turf Club Members,

***SANTA ANITA – 01/10/2026 – ALL WINNERS LISTED ON TEN RACE CARD!  
LISTED COAST TO COAST PICK 5 - \$9,897.10!***



**Wow!** The powerful **Trackpro Value Rating (TPV)** algorithm handicapped, and listed every single winner on the ten race Santa Anita card yesterday! And not only that, the **TPV** also listed the **\$1.00 Coast to Coast PICK 5 (3 x 3 x 3 x 3 x 4)** in R8 at Santa Anita that paid a wallet-busting **\$9,897.10** for subscriber's! **Trackpro** was hoping the **TPV** could have handicapped the Coast to Coast PICK 5 payoff in the top three selections at Gulfstream Park and Santa Anita yesterday, but it was not to be!

But nonetheless, the **TPV** algorithm found the right horses from the relatively large fields, and variety of races that comprised the five race sequence shown below:

**Trackpro** is very often amazed at the horses the **TPV** selects for the daily reports, because sometimes the horses do not look that obvious on paper, and sometimes the **TPV** selects a first time starter for example that is facing more experienced horses that have had previously raced. A perfect example of this was in the first leg of the CTC PICK 5 at Gulfstream Park in R8 shown below:

The winner in the first leg was the #3 THUNDEROUSLY (**\$9.60**) sired by GUN RUNNER, and was showing **Notable Gate Works (/)** in the past performances.

This three year old colt was purchased for **\$300K** by WATHNAN RACING, and was the only first time starter in the entire nine horse field! The fact that the **TPV** algorithm evaluates both pedigree and workouts when parsing the past performances, was no doubt the reason this colt was selected for the report to start the listed \$1 PICK 5 (**\$9,897.10**) for subscriber's! To put this outstanding selection in perspective, one competing service over at Equibase listed six horses for their subscriber's in R8 at Gulfstream Park yesterday, and still missed listing the winner in their top four picks! And another service which did not list the winner at all in their main report had a footnote that read: "*Unknown Running Style: THUNDEROUSLY (9/2)...*" **Trackpro** has no clue how their algorithm handles first time starters with respect to a so called "fair odds line" which the service provides, but I do know that the **TPV** algorithm obviously has no problem putting first time starters in the reports, even when they are facing more experienced horses. And make no mistake, the field in R8 at GP yesterday was not a group of so called "proven losers" either! In fact, the majority of the horses were making only their second or third career start, and all of the contenders were very well bred for the most part. So hats off to the **TPV** for listing the winner to start the PICK 5.

Notice the winner in R4 at Santa Anita shown above was also a first time starter facing seven horses that had previously raced in the nine horse field! And once again, a competing service over at Equibase listed six horses for their



subscriber's in this race, and still missed listing the winner! Why do I say this? Only to point out to the **Turf Club** how truly unique and powerful the **TPV** algorithm really is at finding horses that figure to win, based on nothing else but Comprehensive Handicapping! Every detail in the past performances is important, and needs to be taken into consideration to have the best chance of finding winning horses consistently. Why? Because at the end of the day, it is the little details showing in the past performances that can point out a winning thoroughbred. A high J/T ROI for example which is a handicapping factor often overlooked. A horse may be gelded which often leads to an improved race. A horse may be bred extremely well specifically for turf racing. As a matter of fact, the winner #9 DARK OMEN (**\$5.80**) was sired by OM, a fantastic turf sire for sure! Read the following paragraph taken from the internet: "*Om (sired by Munnings) won 7 races in his career, the vast majority of which were on turf. Key details regarding his turf career include: Total Turf Wins: While he had 7 total wins in 32 starts, his top performances and recorded wins were on the turf, including the 2015 Del Mar Derby (G2T), 2015 Twilight Derby (G2T), 2015 Mathis Brothers Mile S. (G2T), and 2018 Thunder Road Stakes (G3). Grade 1 Turf Placed: He was a high-level turf performer, finishing second twice in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (G1T). Track Record: He set a track record at Churchill Downs for 5 1/2 furlongs on the turf (1:02.24).*" So there you go!

The winner in R11 at GP shown above was the #10 SOUPER ZONDA (**\$14.60**). **Trackpro** is not sure how the morning line odds maker came up with the **8-1**

morning line on the winner, because this contender was marked with a total of six **Trackpro Handicapping Tools**, was ridden by John Velazquez, and was sired by the great CURLIN. Once again, the **TPV** did an outstanding job handicapping this nine horse field, because there were plenty of competing services that simply could not come up with the #10 SOUPER ZONDA (**\$14.60**) for their subscriber's, which also qualified as a Double Overlay! **Trackpro** gets paid to put overlooked horses in the reports, and this race provides a perfect example of doing just that! And by the way, take a look at the vertical payoffs shown above. The listed \$2.00 Exacta returned **\$92.40**, and the listed \$2.00 Triple Double Overlay "key" paid a very nice **\$345.80**!
